How to Use Question Groups

Question groups offer a way for instructors to quickly create Canvas quizzes from premade questions.

- 1. To use a question group you must first create a bank (Using question banks).
- 2. Once you have created a bank, a group can be used as a section in a quiz that pulls in questions from a bank. To do this, first click on the Quizzes course tool

3. Create a new quiz by clicking 'Create a New Quiz'.



4. Add a question group by clicking 'New Question Group'.
